### Large Orchestra Rehearsals

Students will experience playing with a large group of new friends from various schools.

Students have the opportunity to play Orff instruments in addition to their string instrument.

#### Recreation

#### Concerts

Each evening ends with a concert. Professional musicians on the first night, our talented staff on the second night, and the last evening of each session ends with a camper showcase concert for parents, friends, and family members!









### The Staff

The WISTA Orchestra Camp faculty is comprised of school orchestra teachers from the Madison and Milwaukee areas. An integral part of our camp staff includes counselors who are primarily college age students. Together, our counselors and teachers provide instruction in instrumental technique, performance, and Orff as well as supervise campers as they experience the beautiful outdoors while swimming, canoeing and hiking!



## Camp Facilities

Camp Whitcomb-Mason is located in Hartland, WI and is run by the Boys & Girls Club of Greater Milwaukee. The majority of camp activities take place in James Lodge where the main rehearsal spaces, the final concert venue, and sleeping accommodations are located. Barrack-style rooms house 12 campers in bunk beds with showers and lavatories are found across the hall. Meals are served cafeteria style in the same building. Lake Keesus and the swimming pool are just a short walk away!
